South Cliff Park and Ride and the two pick-up and drop-off points at the Harbour Top (coach) and the Spa Promenade (land train) include:

The Park and Ride service

The seasonal complimentary link to the town centre is available to all persons who are part of the travelling party, who have paid to use the South Cliff long stay car park (max 7 persons per vehicle).

Whilst the car park allows for direct access to the beach and other facilities it also provides for a Park and Ride service, operating throughout the summer until the end of September.

The Spa Light Explorer Coach (supported by the Spa Light Express) operates between 9.00am and 6.00pm. Some service times and operating hours may vary throughout the season, particularly in holiday periods and weekends. Please check on site for up-to-date service details.

The site and service is unique in that your day at the seaside starts when you park at this family friendly location, with all the services and direct access to beach and promenade walks or just explore the sand dunes along this beautiful coast line.

Bridlington Park and Ride is situated approximately a mile to the south of the resort and can be easily accessed from the north and south via the well-signed road links.

From Driffield, West Yorkshire and South Yorkshire follow A614 to Carnaby Roundabout, take 2nd exit signed A165 Bridlington South. Continue along A165 to Wilsthorpe Roundabout, take 1st exit signed A1038 Bridlington South & Central. Continue along A1038 to South Cliff Roundabout, take 2nd exit to Park and Ride.

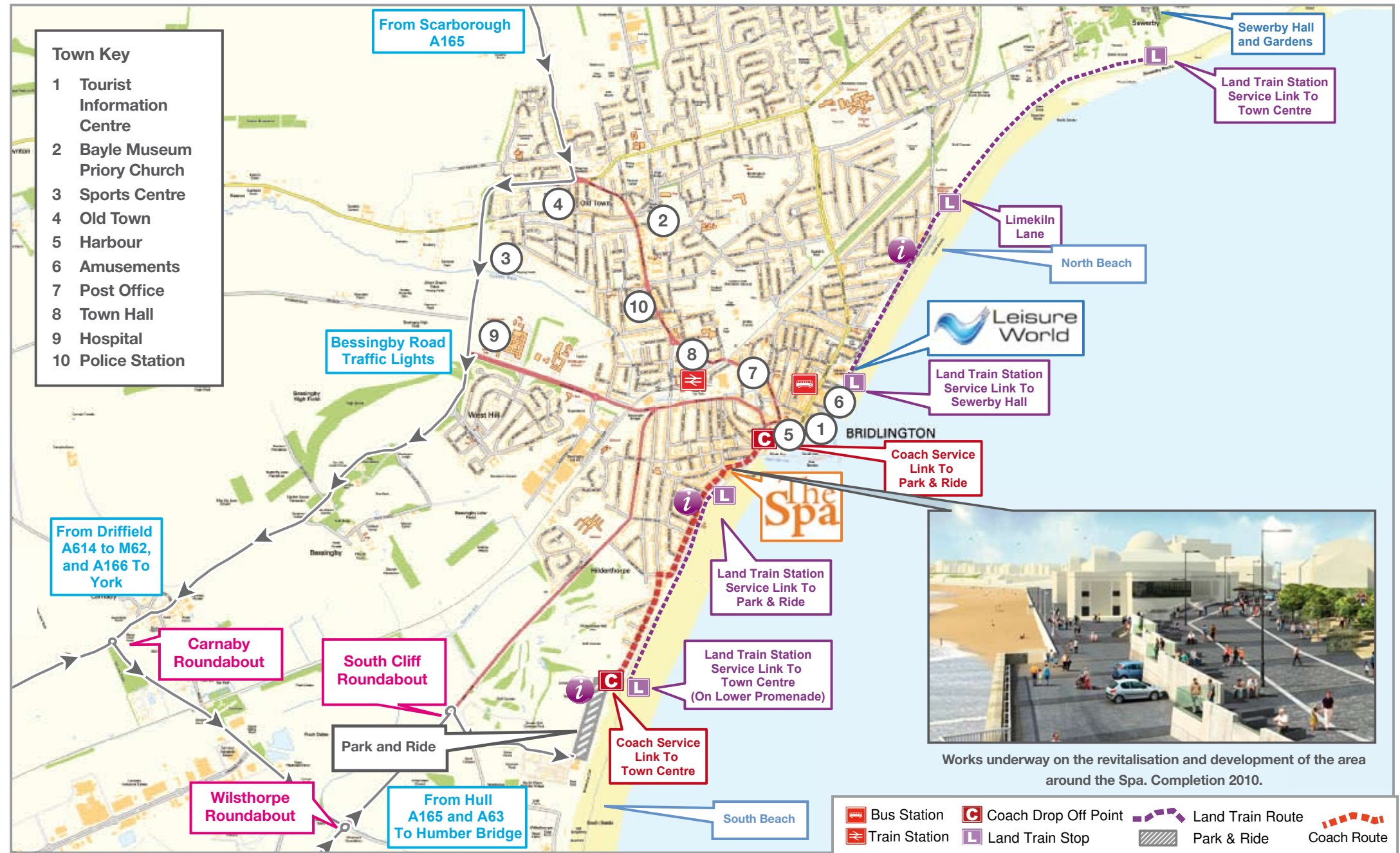
From Hull and Beverley follow A165 to Wilsthorpe Roundabout, take 2nd exit signed A1038 Bridlington South & Central. Continue along A1038 to South Cliff Roundabout, take 2nd exit to Park and Ride.

From Scarborough, North Bridlington and North Yorkshire follow A165 to Carnaby Roundabout, take 1st exit signed A165 Bridlington South. Continue along A165 to Wilsthorpe Roundabout, take 1st exit signed A1038 Bridlington South & Central. Continue along A1038 to South Cliff Roundabout, take 2nd exit to Park and Ride.
